### Project Description



- Conforming Rezoning from Industrial Park to Combined Industrial/Commercial
- Conditional Use Permit: Construction and operation of a private school, toddler through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Seven building. Four phases, maximum enrollment of 2,744 students and 480 faculty/staff.
- Vesting Tentative Map
- Environmental Impact Report



# Community Outreach & Planning Commission Recommendation

- Joint Community and Environmental Scoping meeting on July 18, 2019
  Timeline for permits, school operations, and traffic circulation
- September 23, 2020 Planning Commission voted to recommend City Council:
  - 1. Adopt a Resolution certifying the Avenues: The World School Project Environmental Impact and related MMRP;
  - 2. Approve the rezoning ordinance;
  - 3. Adopt a Resolution approving the Tentative Map, subject to conditions; and
  - 4. Adopt a Resolution approving the Conditional Use Permit, subject to conditions.
