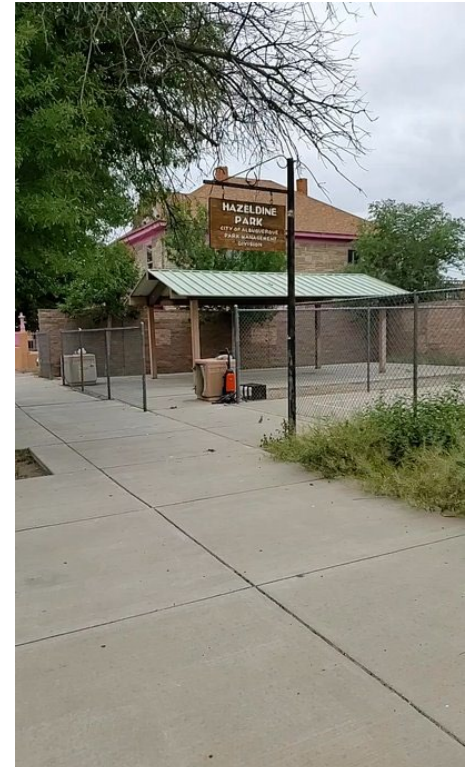

This Project Will Implement Priority Safety Improvements Including Enhanced Pedestrian And Bicycle Crossings, Trail Upgrades, And Connectivity Improvements That Align With The City's Newly Updated Traffic Code And Demonstrate Our Commitment To Preventing Future Tragedies.
- **Gateway Youth Phase 2.**
The Gateway Young Adult Facility Fills A Critical Gap In Services For Young Adults Facing Housing Instability. Phase I Demonstrated The Program's Effectiveness, Pairing Housing With Supportive Navigation Services For Residents. Phase II will Renovate The Second Building, Expanding Capacity To Meet The Significant Demand For Youth Focused Supportive Housing And Helping More Young Adults Build Skills, Access Resources, And Reach Long Term Stability.

Girard Boulevard Between Hannett Avenue And Indian School Road Requires Comprehensive Streetscape Improvements To Enhance Safety And Walkability For The Surrounding Neighborhoods. This Project Will Deliver Wider Sidewalks, Shorter Crossings, Street Trees And Landscaping, Green Stormwater Infrastructure, And Enhanced Lighting That Create A Safer, More Attractive Corridor. These Improvements Will Transform Girard Into A Complete Street That Supports Local Businesses, Connects The Community, And Incorporates Sustainable Design Features.

- **Hahn Arroyo Improvements.**

Councilor Fiebelkorn Has Partnered With Bernalillo County Commissioner Olivas To Provide Upgrades To The Hahn Arroyo Between California St And Pennsylvania St. The Design Work Is Underway To Improve The Arroyo Surface And The Pedestrian/Bike Path That Runs Alongside. The Arroyo In This Area Is In Need Of Resurfacing As Storm Water Flow Is Impeded By Cracks And Vegetation Growing In The Arroyo. The Goal For The Path Is To Create An Area That Is A Safe And Pleasant Space For People To Walk And/Or Bike.

- **Jerry Cline Park Improvements.**

With Tennis Courts, A Soccer Field, A Basketball Court, And Paths Connecting To The Tom Bolack Urban Forest, Jerry Cline Park Near Constitution And Louisiana NE Is One Of The Most Heavily Used Recreation Spaces In District 7. Despite That Popularity, Its Playground Is Among The Oldest In The District And Shows It, With Worn Surfaces And Outdated Equipment.

- **Lafayette Park Improvements.**

At Just Half An Acre, Lafayette Park Near Lafayette And Aztec NE Is A Small But Well Used Neighborhood Spot, Anchored By Two Half Basketball Courts. Like Several Of District 7's Older Parks, Its Playground Has Fallen Behind, With Worn Surfacing And Outdated Equipment.

Luecking South Park Sits Along The North Diversion Channel Near Lafayette And Delmar NE, Where A Walking Trail And Open Space Draw Neighborhood Families And Their Dogs Throughout The Year. The Playground Here Is One Of The Oldest In The District, With Worn Surfaces And Outdated Equipment.

- **San Pedro Pedestrian Improvements and Beautification.**

San Pedro Is A Vital Corridor That Requires Enhanced Pedestrian Infrastructure And Beautification To Improve Safety, Walkability, And Quality Of Life For Adjacent Neighborhoods And Businesses. Additional Funding Will Deliver Improvements Such As Widened Sidewalks, Enhanced Crossings, Streetscape Beautification, And Lighting Upgrades To Additional Segments Of The Corridor.

- **Solar Lighting – District 7.**

New Solar Lighting Technology Now Makes Installations More Affordable And Easier To Place, Since These Fixtures Don't Require The Trenching And Electrical Work Traditional Streetlights Need. This Funding Would Allow The City To Install Solar Lights At Trouble Spots For Public Safety, Helping Protect Vulnerable Road Users Like Pedestrians And Cyclists After Dark.

- **Vista Verde Park - Playground Improvements.**

Nestled Near Hannett And Eubank NE, Vista Verde Park Is A Neighborhood Favorite, With A Shaded Playground, Open Grassy Areas For Gathering, And A Walking Path That Loops The Property. Its Playground Is One Of The Oldest In District 7, And Years Of Use Have Left The Surfacing Worn And The Equipment Outdated.

DISTRICT 8 (CITY COUNCILOR DAN CHAMPINE)

- **Bear Canyon Senior Fitness Center.**

Plan, Design, Purchase, Install, Construct, Equip, Furnish, And Construct A Senior Fitness Center At Bear Canyon Senior Center And Otherwise Improve Facilities At The Center.

- **Casa Grande Linear Park.**

Plan, Design, Purchase, Install, Equip, Furnish, And Construct Park Renovations, To Include But Not Limited To Amenities (Tables, Benches, Trash Cans), Playgrounds, Shade Structures, Drinking Fountains, Sanitation, And Lighting At Casa Grande Linear Park.

- **Green Amendment.**

Support An Amendment To Article II (Bill of Rights) Of The New Mexico Constitution That Guarantees All New Mexicans The Basic Right To Clean Air, Clean Water, And A Healthy Environment.

- **Housing Access**

- **Pedestrian Safety.**

Enact Legislation To Fund Programs That Support And Fund Pedestrian Safety Improvements, Including Sidewalks, Crossings, Lighting, Traffic Calming, And Other Infrastructure That Makes Walking Safer And More Accessible Throughout Albuquerque and Bernalillo County, With Priority Given To Corridors And Areas Experiencing The Highest Rates Of Pedestrian Crashes, Serious Injuries, And Fatalities.

- **Strategy for Offsetting Lost Federal Funding with State and Local Funding.**
