

ORDINANCE NO.

AN UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE APPROVING THE DOWNTOWN BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT BUDGET REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024, AS FILED OR MODIFIED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, AND LEVYING THE DOWNTOWN BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ASSESSMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 SPECIFIED IN THE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2023, the City Council adopted a resolution approving the Downtown Business Improvement District Budget Report for Fiscal Year 2023-2024, as filed or modified by the City Council, and levying the Downtown Business Improvement District Assessments for Fiscal Year 2023-2024; and

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2008, this Ordinance was found to be categorically exempt from environmental review per the provisions of Section 15061(b)(3) of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, as amended, under File No. PP08-048;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby adopts the findings and amounts of the Downtown Business Improvement District Assessments for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 specified in Resolution No. _____ adopted on June 6, 2023.

SECTION 2. The Downtown Business Improvement District Assessments specified in Resolution No. _____ and this Ordinance are assessments imposed upon a business in a tourism marketing district, a parking and business improvement area, or a property and business improvement district.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect retroactive to July 1, 2023.
